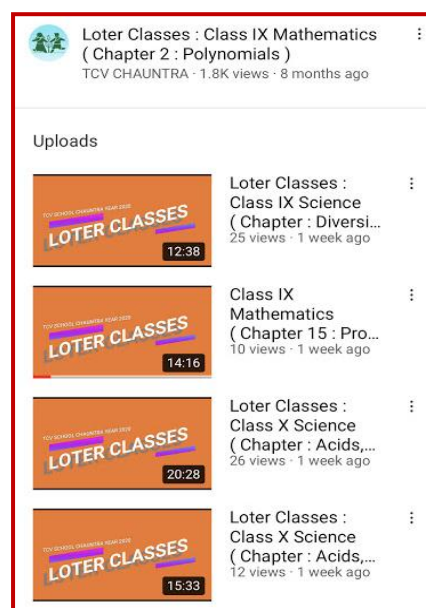
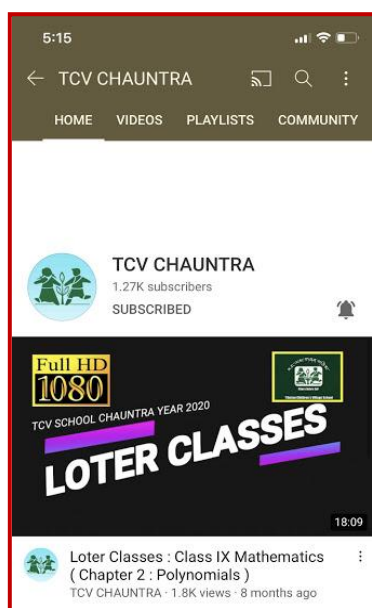
However, as direction received from TCV Head Office, Dharamsala, TCV School Chauntra with a heavy heart had to send our children back home for their welfare and safety. Soon after the school administration found critically important to establish appropriate academic and education programs that can be followed online. So the following routines and structures were followed month after month to upgrade children's knowledge and the elders too.

MARCH 2020

Children below grade 8 were sent back home assigning them with homework targeting the main subjects. Whereas grade 9 and 10 students had to stay back in the school as no specific direction was received from Central Board of Secondary Education related to the Covid -19.

APRIL 2020

TCV Chauntra initiated Loter YouTube classes for some of the key subjects like Science, Mathematics for grade 8, 9 and 10 and Basic Tibetan Language tutorial for the beginners. Library facility was made accessible to children and staff residing in the school.



MAY 2020

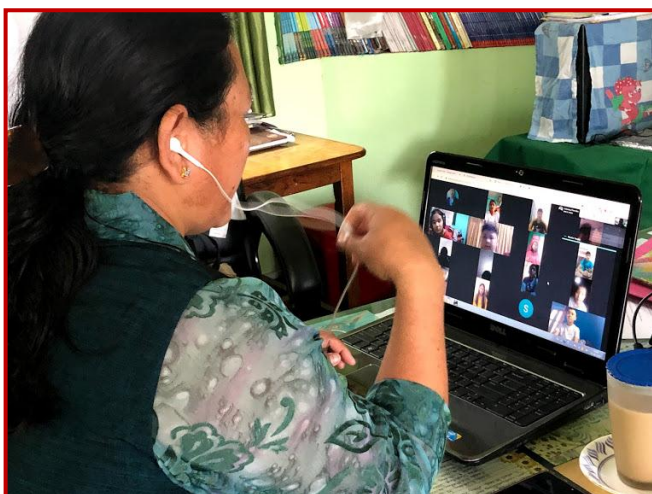
Children who were stranded in the school were provided the tablets and the internet facility was made accessible to watch and learn from the YouTube tutorial posted by the school.

JUNE 2020

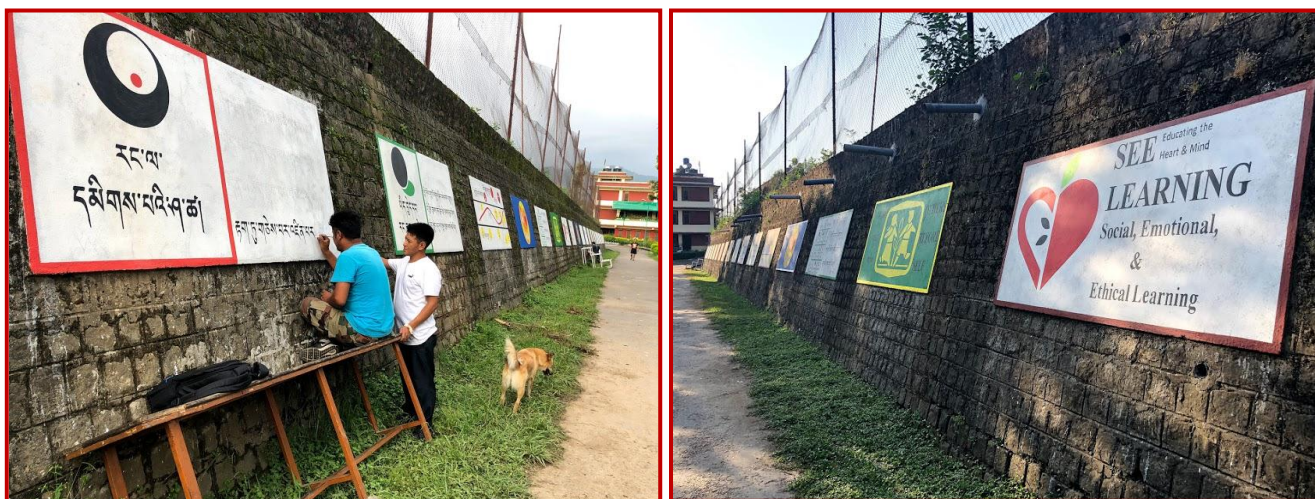
TCV School Chauntra has initiated another significant educational program i.e. the virtual online teaching via Google Meet and Google Classroom for all the subjects and all the different level of classes. Time table for the classes were set up and announced through school website and Facebook. The first ever online virtual teachers' meeting was held in this month to assign work distribution not only to the main subject teachers but the soft teachers were included in the various tasks. For instance, the music teacher was made to open the music room and to tutor music to the children from this month.



JULY 2020

The programs of SEE Learning, Secular Ethics, TPD/PGP were started in this month.

- i) The walls beneath the school football ground and the walls opposite to the staff quarters were inscribed with the quotations and messages from His Holiness the 14th Dalai Lama and other renowned personalities both in Tibetan and English for the residents of the school to read and promote their moral and ethical values.
- ii) The virtual online Tibetan language tutorial (Language Across Curriculum) for the primary teachers was started in this month and continued till date. The classes were organized twice a week on Monday and Friday from 11.00 to 12.00 noon for one hour and are tutored by two TGT Tibetan teachers.



AUGUST 2020

Virtual workshops were organized for the teachers in related to the SEE learning and online teaching skills.

3. On 19th August 2020, a separate meeting with class 10 teachers was held to lay down the plans in case the school reopens and class 10 children return.

SEPTEMBER 2020

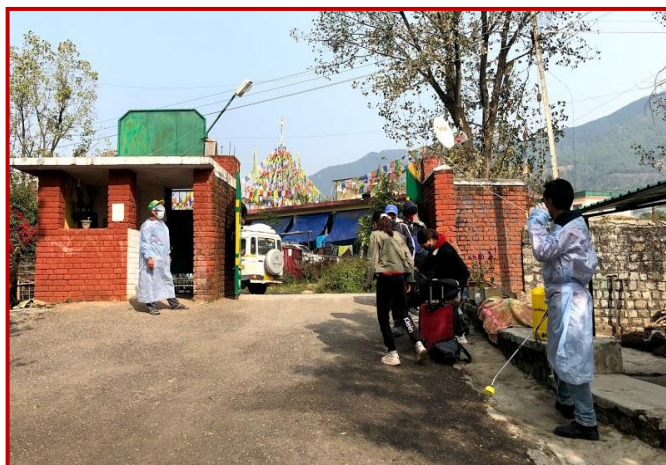
A series of meetings were held by the administrators with the teachers in sections to strengthen and improvise the virtual online teaching.

OCTOBER 2020

2. This month's MC meeting was specifically based on the planning program for the return of the class 10 students – the homes, class etc.
 3. Arrival of class 10 children from 26 – 31 October 2020 and stationing them in their respective quarantine centers.
 4. The administrators meeting with the class 10 teachers to do further planning.
