Status of Students:

1. **Tenzin Changchup Bhutia:** She is currently on one month holiday. She had completed first sessional exam of second year of GNM nursing before the holiday. She will be completing her course on 31st August, 2023. She has plans of doing post Basic nursing after her General Nursing course.

2. **Tenzin Sangmo:** She is in 2<sup>nd</sup> year at Krupanidhi Institute of Nursing. This year they have more postings compared to their first year. Initially their classes were held online for few months after that they attended regular theoretical classes. In the month of April, they did their medical surgical course from HAL Hospital (Hindustan Aeronautic Limited). There they have to deal with neuro related and cardiac patients. The shifts starts from morning 7am till 1pm. They have one VIVA coming up in June thus she has been focusing on that for a time being.

3. **Tenzin Jigmey:** She is in second year and currently she is in her home town for a month holiday. In the month of September they have to go psychiatric posting. She has made friends and her classes are going well. After finishing the three year course in St. Philomena's college of nursing, she is planning to work in same college for 6 months.

4. **Sonam Yangzom:** She is now in her third year and her classes have started little late in the month of March, 2022. In May-June they will have to attend community posting as a part of course completion. For postings they will have to go to different places like community health centre, old age home and blind school. Through these postings she says she get to learn lots of things and help her get new experiences which would be helpful in future when she starts working. They have to do internship which will be from (1st June to the end of November). After completing her course she has plans of doing further studies in post basic nursing degree which will be for two year. Currently their college is in 2 weeks holiday from 22 May- 5 June, 2022.

5. **Ngawang Tzedzom:** She is in second year which has been started from February, 2022. This year, they have specialty posting of pediatric and psychiatric for 7weeks each and medical surgical posting for more than 1000 hours. Till now they have attended one month of theory block and 2 and half months of clinical postings. Internals exam is not over yet and she has been preparing for that by staying in college hostel. So that she could get to discuss with her classmates.
- As a part of postings she was posted in psychiatric ward for four weeks where they have conducted many activities to patients. From her second year of college they were allowed to do night shifts.

Mostly in the morning they attend hospital practical trainings and after lunch their class starts till 4pm. A group of 5 students each are placed in different wards like ICU, General and etc and they take turn wise. This gives them first hand experiences through practical studies and will be useful when they start working.

7. **Tenzin Yeshi:** She is in her third year and she will be completing her course by August, 2022 and planning to do further studies as post basic nursing.
